Latin American Art

Survey course on pre-Colombian and Colonial art and their artistic manifestations.

Problems in Cuban Art I

This course focuses on discussions of trends and problems in the development of Cuban national artistic expression.

Afro-Caribbean Studies

The influence of African culture on Caribbean culture. Includes an examination of syncretic culture, mythological thought, and artistic manifestations with an African component.

Caribbean Art

A general Caribbean art history course that looks at the development of Caribbean art from the early stages to the 20th century.

American Art

A survey of artistic manifestations in the Western Hemisphere from pre-Colombian through Colonial times.

Latin American Literature II

A study of the Latin American literary experience in the 20th century. Literary movements examined include Romanticism, Realism, Naturalism, Modernism, and Postmodernism.

Cuban Literature I

Cuban literature from the Conquest to 1902, including the evolution of theatre in Cuba, literary manifestations during the Ten Years War, and the evolution of poetry from Romanticism to Modernism.

Cuban Literature III

Cuban literature from 1959 to the 1990s including problems and tendencies in the evolution of poetry, the narrative and theatre.

Studies on José Martí.

The life and work of José Martí focusing on his economic, social, and aesthetic ideas and on the evolution of his liberation and anti-imperialist project.

Seminar on Contemporary Cuban Literatura

Cuban literature from the 1940s to the present. This advanced seminar may focus on the works of a single author or on a collection of works with a common theme.

Selected Works of Caribbean Literature

Advanced study of a set of works of Caribbean literature. All may be of a specific author. Works may be from different language areas.

Contemporary Hispanic Poetry

Poetry of Spain and Spanish America from the late nineteenth century to the present, focusing on major poets of the different periods and important literary movements.

History of Cuba

A survey of Cuban history from Pre-Colombian times to the present.
